## How can teachers make use of Kognity's features for differentiated instruction?

An excellent way for teachers to support students through differentiated instruction is by issuing assignments. Assignments can be sent to all of the class or a selection of students, meaning that students who require additional support can complete different assignment questions to their classmates.

Additionally, the dictionary can also be used for differentiation. When teaching or revising a lesson, we can ask students to click on different coloured vocab words, which opens the dictionary definition. Students can then read the word out loud and to copy it into the built-in notebook.
